CALVING REPORT 2019

Time to take a day out of your winter wonderland and complete last falls calving reports, before the new calf crop begins. Danny Meyer is compiling information to see our strengths and weaknesses (if there is such a thing) in the BueLingo calves weaned last fall. He is not only looking for averages on weaning weights. He is collecting information on Polled, scurred, and horned cattle as well. Most of us have been breeding the horns out of our cattle (the best we can) by not using horned bulls, or not using horned cows as breeding stock. Some of our foundation cows have had horns and total elimination of horns may not be possible, but the odds can be lessened through herd management and collecting weaning information in the Fall Calving Report.
